

GREEN UPDATE

Finally, after further negotiations, Greenguage have given us a quote for their original recommendation to level the sides of the green with compacted marble dust. Their quote is a total of £3200 to level both sides of the green and we will provide the materials and machinery, i.e. the marble dust, a cement mixer and wacker plate. A few members can loan cement mixers and wheelbarrows and the wacker plate hire is 35€ a day from Prestige Hire. The marble dust has been sourced locally at 50€ a ton, not including delivery, and we require 7 tons.

The committee feel that this is the best and cheapest option as we are using a professional U.K. green fitter to do all of the work, and they are very experienced. They plan to be here on 9th December and the job will take approximately 10 days. Obviously, the green will be closed at this time.

All committee members have done their bit but special thanks are due to Roy Keningale and Richard Brimble who have done an excellent job preparing the sides of the green with steel lengths and to Maureen Hanratty whose energy and organisational skills in sourcing the materials and liaising with the Town Hall has been invaluable.
